Timetable

Packing

Ask your driver how much luggage you can bring. A soft bag is probably preferable to a suitcase.

Bring boots, pole(s) if you have them, waterproof clothing, umbrella and make sure these are easily accessible for the first walk. You could bring a packed lunch, find a pub on the way, or eat in the café at Brockhole.

Monday

0800 Suggested departure time. Car passengers to liaise with drivers on meeting points and times.

1330 Set out on 4¾ mile walk from Brockhole Lake District Visitor Centre. If the weather is poor, this walk can be shortened.

1600 Return to Brockhole.

1630 Arrive Rydal Hall.

1845 Dinner followed by an illustrated talk about the Lake District by a member of Ambleside U3A.

Tuesday

0800 Breakfast

Either

0900 Leave Rydal Hall and drive via Keswick to Great Wood.

1000 Set out on 4½ mile walk from Great Wood.

1230 Return to car park.

0900 Leave Rydal Hall and drive to Monk Coniston.

0945 Set out on 5 mile walk which includes a circuit of Tarn Hows.

1215 Return to car park.

0945 Set out on a 5 mile walk from Elterwater.
